# **The Cost of Delivering Natural Gas**

There is a great deal of behind-thescenes activity that goes into delivering clean and convenient natural gas to your home. Over the past decade, natural gas production has risen faster than the capacity to transport the gas throughout the United States.

The U.S. natural gas pipeline network is a highly integrated system that moves natural gas throughout the continental United States. This network consists of approximately 3 million miles of transportation and distribution pipelines that link natural gas production areas and storage facilities with consumers. The natural gas supply has steadily increased in recent years to meet the growing demand for natural gas, especially for power generation.

While the cost of the natural gas commodity continues to be relatively flat, the cost to transport natural gas from the producer to you is increasing. In fact, for the first time at York County Natural Gas Authority (YCNGA), the cost to deliver natural gas is higher than the product itself.



Transporting the gas and arranging for services to ensure that gas will be delivered to you on the coldest day (peaking services) will continue to increase as demand for natural gas increases.

As more demand is placed on the gas delivery system, the issue of space available on our pipeline network to transport the product becomes apparent. In 2011, Patriots Energy Group (PEG), a Joint Action Agency consisting of York, Chester and Lancaster

County Natural Gas Authorities, constructed its own pipeline to provide additional supply to the three counties and avoid the increased cost of capacity from other providers.

Currently, PEG is taking a proactive stance and working on an engineering study to define its future infrastructure needs as demand in the three counties continues to grow at a record pace. As a public natural gas utility, YCNGA's focus is providing reliable, safe and affordable service to our community.

# DO YOU USE AUTO-PAY?



## HERE ARE SOME TIPS & REMINDERS...

- When setting up Auto-Pay, don't enter a maximum amount to pay — if the bill is higher than that amount, the payment will not go through.
- Payment due dates are never set for holidays or weekends, so your due date may change each month, within a day or two. When setting up Auto-Pay select the option (checkbox) to have your payment made on the due date to avoid late fees.
- Be sure to update credit/debit cards that may have expired, or when switching checking accounts or e-check drafts.
- **Best Bet** Set up alerts on your account that will notify you each month when your payment has been processed. Otherwise, you may not receive notice that a payment has not gone through until a disconnect notice is mailed out.




Get fast, secure account access with the YCNGA APP available for your Apple and Android devices. View your bill and account balance, make payments by credit, debit or e-check, schedule alerts and reminders, and opt-in to push notifications for outages or bill reminders. # Budgets Love Levelized Billing bills are often

**N**atural gas bills are often higher in the winter since natural gas is typically used for heating. Enroll in our Levelized Billing Program (LBP) and know what to expect each month when your bill arrives.

We analyze your charges over the past 12 months to project the cost for the next 12 months, then divide your predicted usage into 11 equal payments. On the 12th month we reconcile the account and either bill the difference owed, or credit the amount to next year's plan.



#### HOW TO ENROLL

Call Customer Service at 803-323-5304 **AFTER** you receive your May bill. Enrollment closes June 7. You must have 12 months of billing history to be eligible for the program.

#### ALREADY ENROLLED

We will analyze your LBP account after the May bill and make any necessary adjustments. There is no need to call. The new payment amount will be shown on your June billing statement. Any credit on your account will be applied to next year's calculation, reducing the amount of your levelized monthly payment. If a balance is owed, you will receive a bill for that amount.



# **Keep Your Service Active Over the Summer**

Customers who disconnect and later reconnect at the same service location are charged a service fee of \$125. Stay connected for a minimum of \$10 per month and avoid the extra charges. With year-round service you may qualify for a lower rate and participate in our Levelized Billing Program (LBP).

Whether planting a tree, or digging a mailbox post, every digging job that requires a shovel, requires a call to SC811. # IF YOU SMELL GAS. ACT FAST! **Our Gas Smells BAD for a GOOD Reason**

Natural gas leaks are rare, but can occur. To alert you to a leak, an odorant called Mercaptan is added to natural gas to give it that tell-tale rotten egg smell. If you suspect a leak, call us right away to inspect. Night or day, we'll inspect a suspected leak at no charge to you.

# Signs of a natural gas pipeline leak:

- The smell of rotten eggs
- Dead or discolored vegetation
- A hissing or roaring sound
- Persistent bubbles in streams, ponds or wet areas
- Dirt or debris blowing into the air
- Flames (if a leak has ignited)

# If you suspect a leak:

- Leave the area immediately and warn others to stay away
- Do not use a phone or device that could create a spark and ignite the gas
- Call 911 and 1-866-201-1001

Our approved contractors wear utility inspector colors (yellow), carry an ID badge and drive vehicles with a YCNGA contractor magnet on the door. # THIS IS A REEL NO-NO!



The gas meter at your property is the entry point for natural gas into your home. Keep the area around your gas meter clear of any obstructions and never hang garden hoses or lean tools against your meter. These items may damage the connections resulting in a leak or improper reading of your gas meter.
